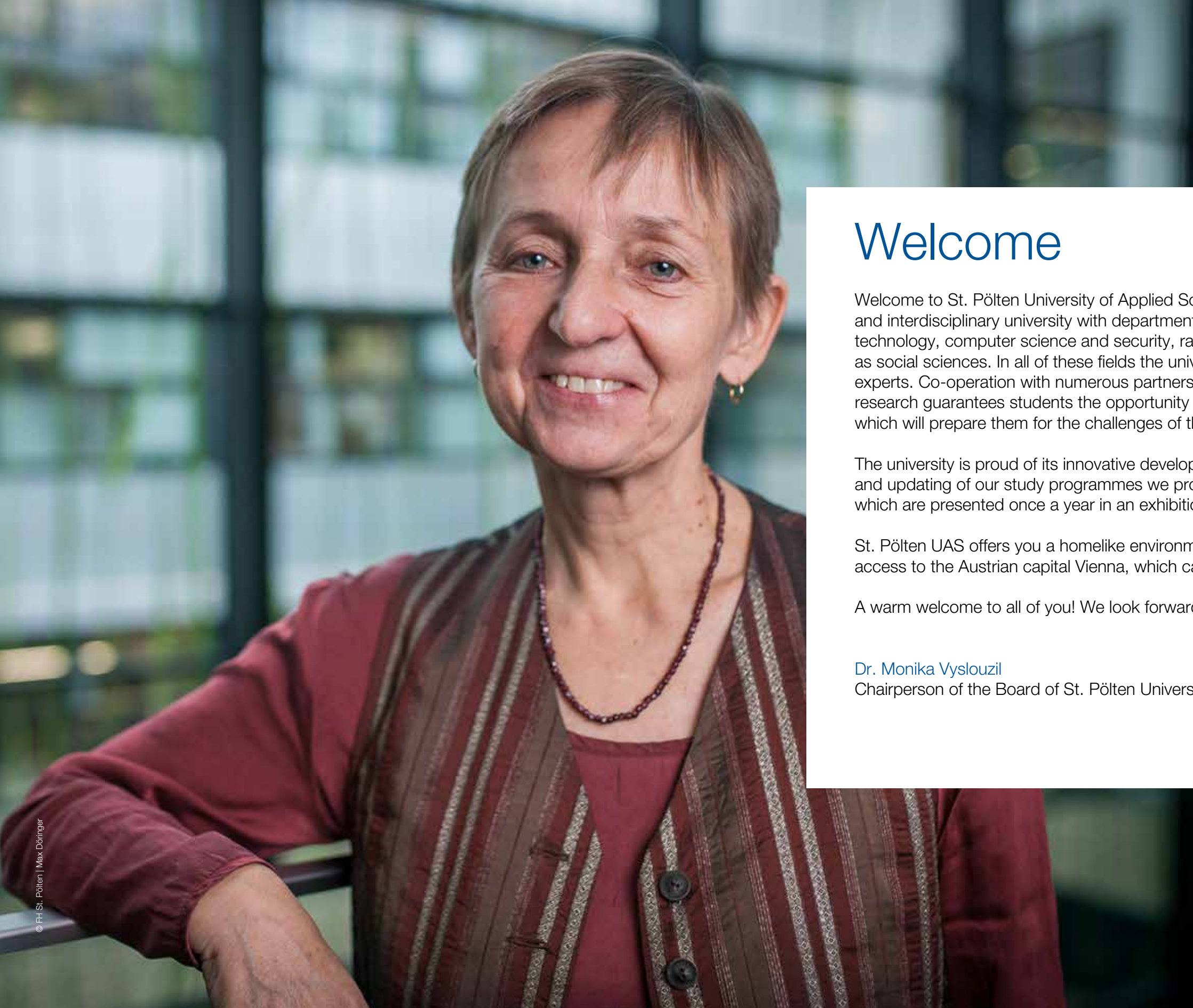

# Learning German

In addition you are welcome to attend a German language class. A three-week preparatory German course takes place each year in September, and during term time a course in German Language and Austrian Culture (Beginners/Advanced, 7 ECTS credits) is available to international students.

# Cost of Studying and Living

Students at St. Pölten UAS pay a tuition fee of €363.36 per semester (EU rate), plus €19.20 for membership in the Student Union. Incoming exchange students on the Erasmus programme are exempt from paying tuition fees.

Whilst living in Austria, you should factor in an average expenditure of approximately €800 a month, which includes accommodation.

## In and Around St. Pölten

The city of St. Pölten with its population of 54,000 is the government centre of Lower Austria. It is situated 60 km west of the Austrian capital Vienna and well connected by rail and motorway to all other major Austrian cities.

St. Pölten is a Baroque town with a history dating back to the period of the Roman occupation. It offers year round a wide variety of programmes including performances, exhibitions, music festivals and other cultural events. Near the city and the campus you will find river walkways, an extensive network of bicycle paths as well as three lakes, which offer swimming, boating and outdoor dining.

St. Pölten is a perfect point of departure from which to explore the rest of Austria. The cities of Vienna and Salzburg, the famous Wachau wine-growing region of the Danube Valley and the mountains and lakes of the Salzkammergut are only a day trip away. Take a weekend and expand your international experience by visiting the nearby countries of Germany, the Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary, Slovenia, Italy or Switzerland.
