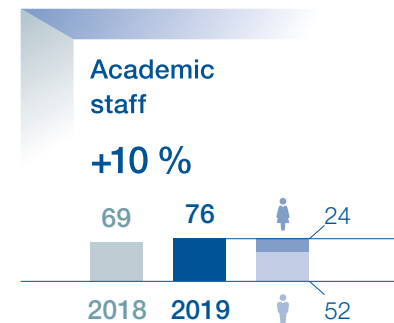
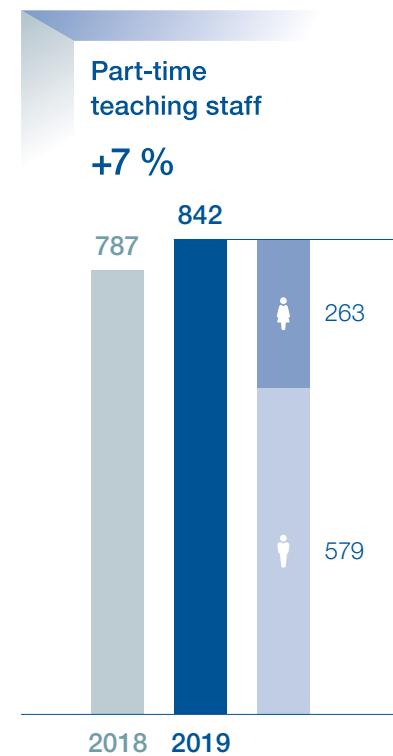
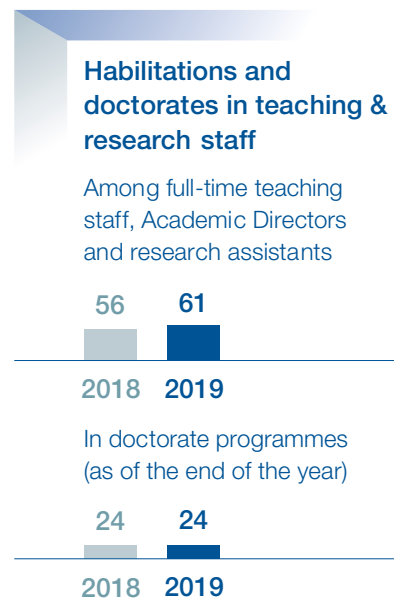
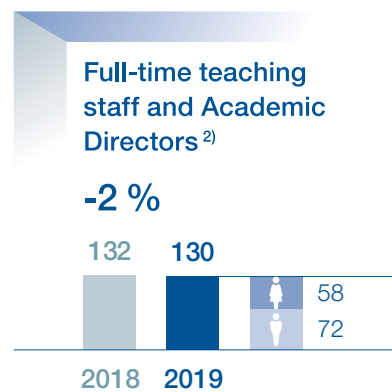
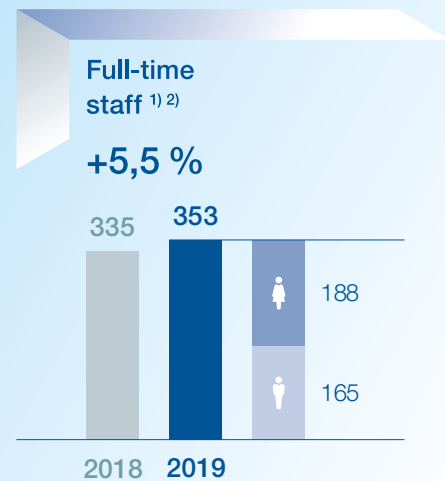
About St. Pölten UAS

The St. Pölten UAS managed to increase the number of its staff members once again in 2019, thus reinforcing its position as an important employer in the region.

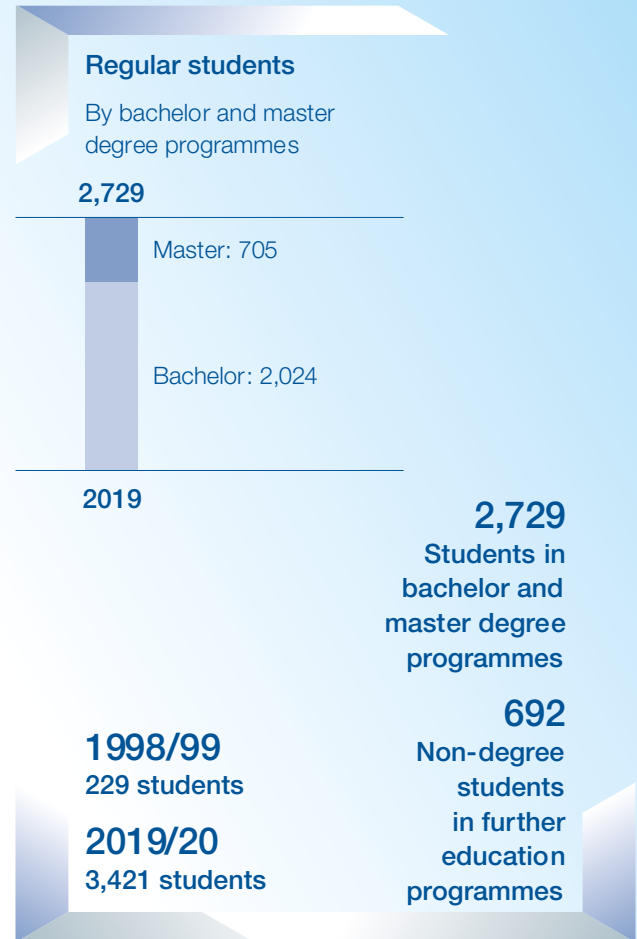
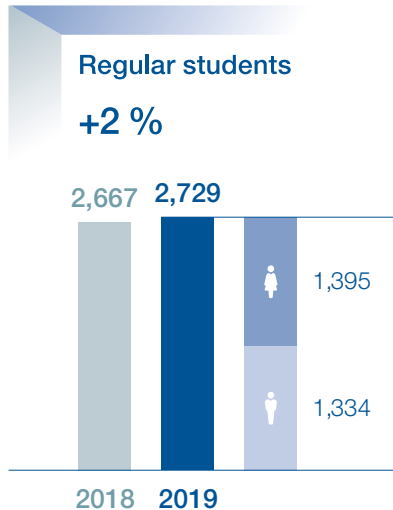


**1,175

Excellent career opportunities and a future-oriented education: The number of students has been increasing steadily since the foundation of the St. Pölten UAS.

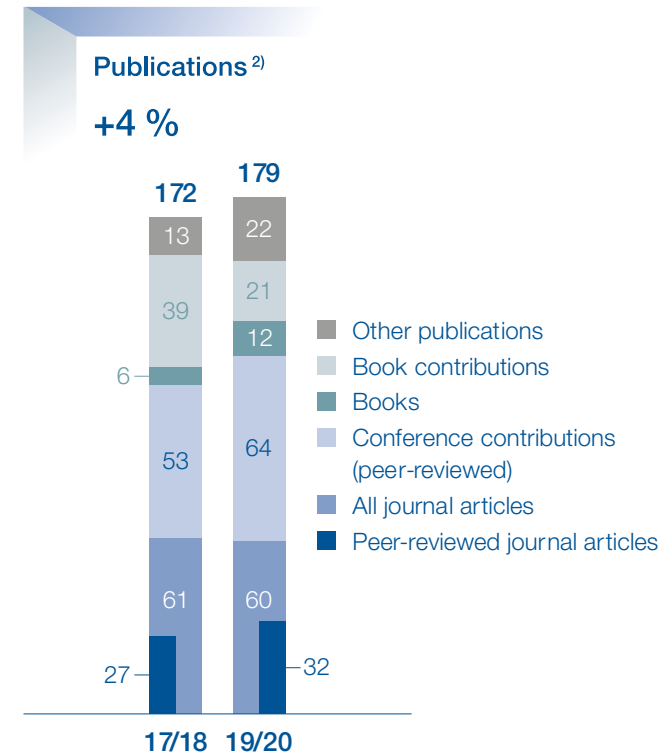


Research & International Affairs

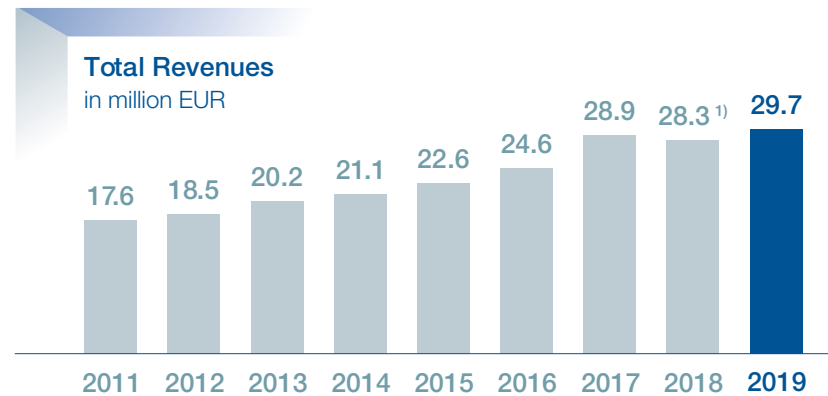

Total Revenues 2019



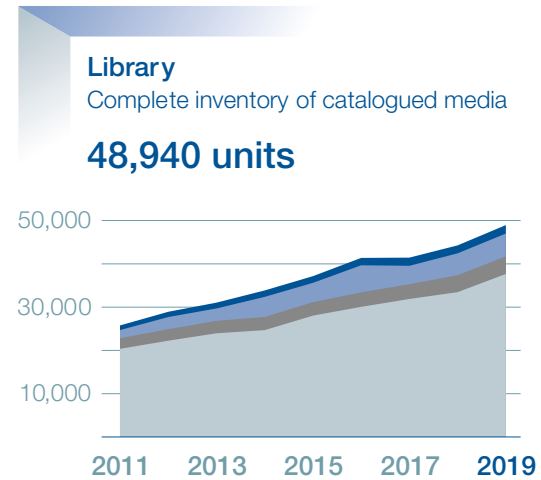

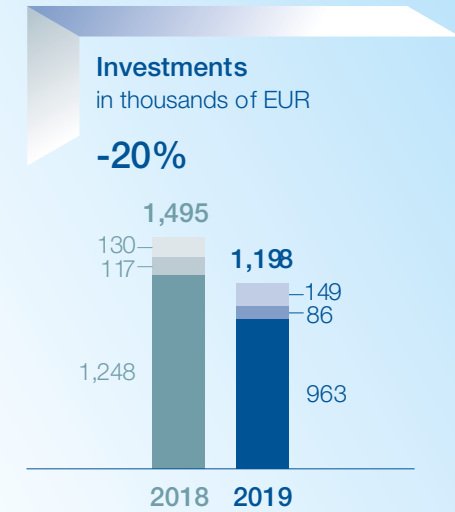
