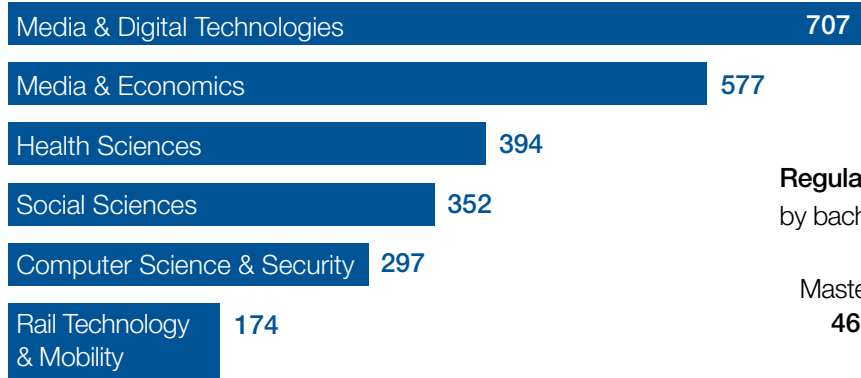

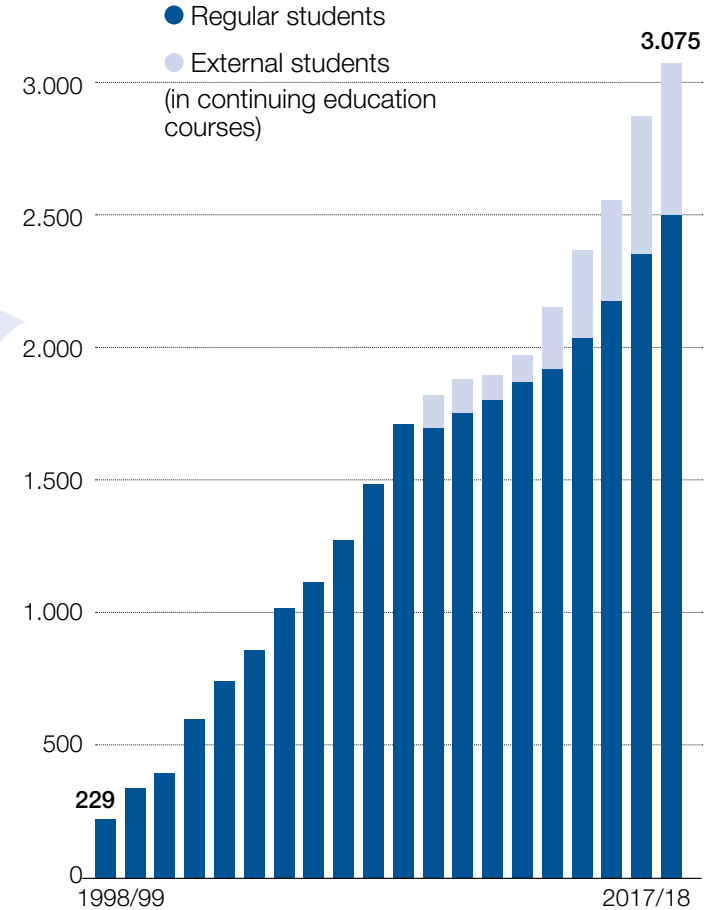

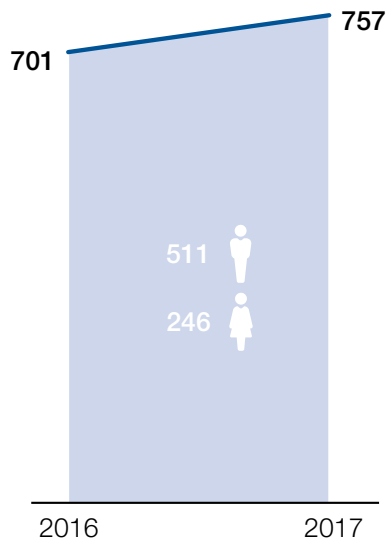
Development of student numbers

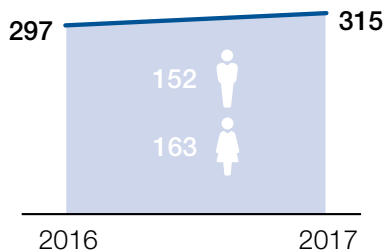

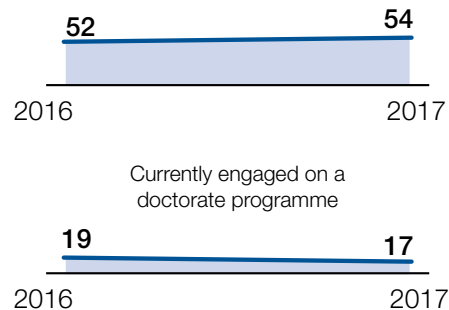

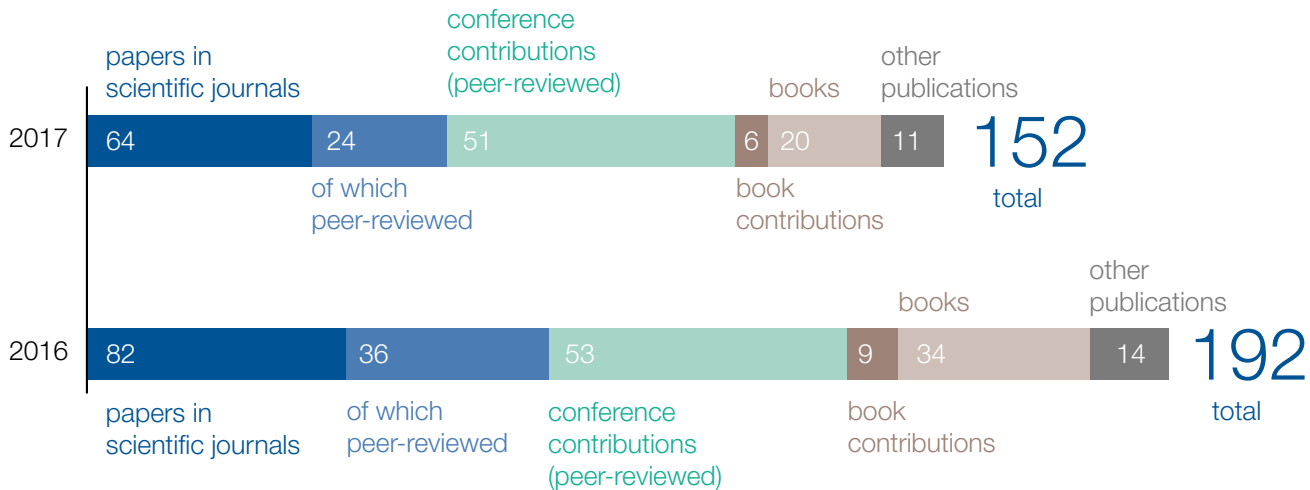
