

The EPS is a joint initiative of European universities open to students who have completed at least two years of studies and want to gain experience abroad in an interdisciplinary context.

For one whole semester, participating students work on predetermined projects in the focus areas of Edutainment, Data, Engineering, and Journalism.

Accompanying courses provide the basis for the successful completion of the programme. We offer excellent working conditions to our students. The projects are carried out in cooperation with the numerous practice labs, ensuring that the students have access to state-of-the-art equipment and facilities.
